Cruise Whitsundays Reefworld

The Reefworld pontoon, moored at Hardy Reef, is a unique attraction that provides access to the Great Barrier Reef while supporting the region's natural environment. Working hand-in-hand with the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority, Reefworld takes a sustainable and environmentally conscious tourism approach, delivering reef education and conservation guidance, through a range of remarkable experiences, including guided snorkelling and dive tours, admiring the abundant marine life from the underwater observatory, up-close reef exploration in a semi-submersible or optional helicopter scenic flights. Guests keen to experience the reef can choose between two unique accommodation options: Reefsleep, or the underwater Reefsuites.

Bowen Tourism and Business The Big Mango

The Big Mango is located next to the Bowen Visitor Information Centre, 5km south of Bowen at the top of the Whitsundays.

The mango was built in May 2002 and celebrated its 20th anniversary in 2022. Bowen has a population of about 8,500. The Visitor Information centre next to the Big Mango attracts more than 40,000 visitors annually.

Thousands more stop at the Big Mango for a selfie next to this iconic tourist attraction.

Bowen Tourism and Business operate the Visitor Information Centre - a not-for-profit organisation supported by 245 members and operates seven days a week.

Great Barrier Reef Festival

The Great Barrier Reef Festival takes pride in inclusively connecting the reef to the shore and celebrates the coastal region of the Whitsundays at the heart of the Great Barrier Reef. There truly is something for everyone, from our Friday Night Fireworks and Live Music to the Revvin the Reef Car Show, free Family Fun Day, Comedy Gala and much more!

New to the Great Barrier Reef Festival is the Immerse Underwater Art Installation – Bringing the reef to the Airlie Beach foreshore created using recycled products. And The Master Reef Guide educational experiences, including interactive workshops and guided tours to the outer Great Barrier Reef and Whitsunday Islands.

As a community and tourism event, local businesses and citizen support make this festival happen, all are invited to be involved and BE PART OF SOMETHING GREAT!

The Great Barrier Reef festival attracts approximately 12,000 attendees to The Whitsundays and injects half a million dollars into the local economy.

Kiana Sail and Dive

MS Kiana is a sailing vessel chosen specifically to ensure minimal environmental impact as we discover Outer Reefs that are extremely remote with our 5Day/4Night 'Explore the Unexplored' Expeditions. These expeditions are designed for research, monitoring, and coral predation control programs delivering a unique immersive experience for national and international guests.

Kiana also offers a 3Day/2Night' Whitsunday Island' Expedition. Showcasing our natural wonder focusing on conservation, and protecting our World Heritage Area.
